ABOUT THE HALL OF FAME

The purpose of the Jerome High School Activities Hall of Fame is to recognize and honor those Jerome High School athletes, participants, coaches, administrators, and supporters who excelled in their respective sports, activities, or coaching/support roles and who helped to bring honor, recognition, distinction, and excellence to Jerome High School by their conduct both in and out of their field of competition. This recognition will help maintain the spirit, pride and sense of community as well as serving as a historical account of the great traditions of Jerome High School.

NOMINATION ELIGIBILITY

Athletes/Participants are eligible for nomination 10 years after their class's graduation. Any nominee must be in good standing or in special circumstances as determined by the Board Members.

The selection committee will use the following achievements as "guidelines" for selection purposes:

- Competed on a conference team, and/or
- Competed in a state tournament as an individual or was on a team that qualified for state competition and/or
- Earned a letter in a more than one sport or earned multiple letters in a single sport, and/or
- Earned a championship title in an individual sport, and/or
- Earned an MVP award in a selected sport, was voted to an all-state team or an all-conference team, and/or
- Was a statistical leader or a record holder in a selected sport.
- Excelled academically while excelling at extra-curricular activities.

Nomination is also open to coaches and boosters who must have participated with distinction and/or made significant contributions to programs at Jerome High School, as evidenced, for example, by the success of their teams and the acknowledgment of their former student-athletes. Such coaches shall be eligible for nomination beginning five years after they have left Jerome High School for any reason, or in special circumstances as determined by the Board Members. A time expectation does not apply to boosters.

NOMINATION PROCESS

A candidate may be nominated for Hall of Fame membership by any member of the community. Formal nomination shall be made using the nomination form prescribed for such purpose and made available to the public. The nomination form must be received by the athletic department by September 31st. All applications are to remain confidential, to be shared among the members of the Board only. Information relating to a nominee's career statistics, records, achievements, etc. must be supported by accompanying documentation or sources cited so that the information may be verified independently.

Once presented as an eligible nominee, a candidate who is not elected shall automatically be reconsidered annually until he/she has been considered for five years. Thereafter, re-nomination may occur at any time. The Chairman will notify any nominator and their nominee in writing if not selected.
